Go to our website at [www.mahiafishingclub.com](http://www.mahiafishingclub.com) and complete the online application form. You can pay online. Your tractor key and other information will be sent to your home address.

The application process takes 10 days so to avoid disappointment please do not wait until you arrive in Mahia to arrange your Membership and Tractor Key.

If you are a current member, you will be automatically reinvoiced.

## **SPECIAL NOTES**

Only financial members can obtain and use a Tractor Key.

As a Tractor Key holder, I maybe reliable for the cost of recovery and insurance excess if I am responsible for, swamping or damaging a tractor through neglect or misuse.
